



CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

06/4/2026

Dear Residents and Businesses,
The City has contracted with Excel Paving Company to perform multiple street and pavement rehabilitation work along Wilshire Blvd and vicinity streets impacted by long-term construction activities from Metro Purple (D) Line Extension.

What to Expect:

- Lane reductions and road closures. At least, one lane in each direction will be maintained. Major closures and detours will be limited to weekends or nights.
- If necessary, intermittent overnight or weekend activity may take place. No noisy activity will be allowed between 8pm and 7am.
- Driveway, pedestrian, and business access will be maintained during construction.
- "No Parking" signs will be posted, and street parking near work areas will be temporarily restricted. **Limited overnight parking exemption passes may be available upon request and subject to City approval.**
- Dust and noise. Mitigation measures will be in place.

WHAT:

Wilshire Boulevard and Vicinity Street Improvements –

- Curb Ramp improvements
- Curb and Gutter spot repairs
- Roadway spot repairs
- Bus Stop – concrete pad repairs and installation

WHEN:

Start on June 15th 2026, and last approximately 8 weeks, with work at each location taking about 1.5 weeks.

Typical work hours, including traffic control set-up, will be Monday through Saturday, 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. (weather permitting), and may vary by activity and location.

WHERE:

Work will begin on the south side of Wilshire Blvd and progress to the north side at all intersections and blocks between Rexford Dr and Robertson Blvd, including block frontages at:

- Rexford Dr
- Maple Dr
- Palm Dr
- Oakhurst Dr
- Doheny Dr
- Wetherly Dr
- Almont Dr
- La Peer Dr
- Swall Dr
- Clark Dr
- Robertson Blvd
